
On April 8, 2013 the Chatsworth Community Coordinating Council (CCCC) Board voted unanimously to support the Santa Susana Mountain Park Association's drive to have the National Parks Administration become the owner and custodian of the NASA property in the Santa Susana Field Laboratory that is currently being offered for sale by the General Services Administration.

The many local organizations that the CCCC coordinates are vitally concerned about the eventual disposition of this land after the DTSC cleanup is certified, and support the effort to have the entire 2600 acres of the Field Laboratory remain open land and parkland in perpetuity.
