NEXT MEETING: Mon. 21, 7:45 p.m., Hospitality Room, Glendale Federal Savings and Loan, 21821 Devonshire (corner of Vassar) in Chatsworth. Subject of meeting: "Where do we go from here?" We need your input!

SINCE THE LAST MEETING 1. Incorporation procedures have progressed- Don Gudis is helping us with the legalities at a saving of around \$200. 2. We went to Sacramento June 3 and spoke to Calif. Parks Director Wm. Penn Mott. The bill AB2470 passed the Natural Resource and Conservation Committee at that time as did SJR 23. AB2470 now goes to Ways and Means for the \$10,000 feasibility allocation. (Letters are needed in support to Willie Brown Jr., Chairman, Ways and Means Comm., State Capitol, Sac. 95814). 3. CALVIN HAMILTON, city planning chief, toured Chatsworth all day June 5 with us and said the city would like to incorporate parts of the county where the park is. The city cultural heritage board could then protect areas of historical significance. While touring the StageCoach Trail area, Hamilton discovered a huge bathtub-size basin which has been confirmed by Bob Pence, Pierce College Archeologist, as another Indian site! 4. Received letters from Simi Mayor, Senator John Tunney, and Chatsworth CC (in part), in support of park. 5. Jan spoke at county budget hearings June 9 and also received a resolution of support, but funds are lacking now, they say. We told them the area is being considered in the National urban parks study.

THANK YOU for all your letters to Sacramento and for attending the budget hearings!
